Concerning the reorganization of our consolidated subsidiaries.

As part of a plan to strengthen our consolidated management, we have decided to reorganize our consolidated subsidiaries and would like to give you the details as follows.

1.Aims and details.

The severity of the business environment around us is becoming more grave, as apart from the state of the art technology sector: customers are shifting overseas, product prices are falling and the participation in the market of foreign makers' products is causing domestic demand to stagnate and competition to become more and more intense for manufacturers both here and abroad. Also business accounting is in the midst of a trend where consolidation is considered important and the superiority or inferiority of consolidated management has become the key to business evaluation. In the middle of this, we too have been regarding the 'strengthening of our consolidated management' as a top priority management issue and up to now we have

Now, we will merge our 6 geographically close domestic consolidated subsidiaries into 3 groups where a synergy effect by integration from the point of view of business type can be expected and, as a result, consolidated competitive power is going to be strengthened by ensuring the improvement of business efficiency.
